A BIT OF HISTORY: **COMPOST KIDS WAS LAUNCHED** IN 2010 AT THE MARKET HALL IN SHREWSBURY BY SAM POOLEY-STRIDE. FUN **CLASSES WITH A BASIS IN** HISTORY OF ART FOR CHILDREN **OF ALL AGES, THE IDEAS** WAS THAT ART CONCEPTS. **HOWEVER COMPLICATED COULD BE INTERPRETED BY** KIDS AND THAT THEY COULD LEARN TO CREATE WITHOUT PATRONISING THEM. COMPOST KIDS RAN FOR AN AMAZING SIX YEARS SAM AND DAISY, HER DAUGHTER TOOK ART TO **BIRTHDAY PARTIES. EVENTS** AND FESTIVALS AROUND SHROPSHIRE. DAISY WENT ON TO DO HER DEGREE IN FINE ART AT FALMOUTH SCHOOL OF ART AND IS CURRENTLY STUDYING HER MASTERS AND SAM HAS **CONTINUED WITH HER OWN** PRACTICE AS A PAINTER.

REALLY HOPE OUR IDEAS WILL
HELP MAKE THINGS A LITTLE
EASIER!

HOW IT WORKS: WE HAVE CREATED A SET OF FIVE PLANS FOR EACH SUBJECT. ALL CAN BE DONE IN ONE WAY OR ANOTHER BY PEOPLE AGED 3 - 100. PLEASE NOTE: ART IS ALL ABOUT INTERPRETATION. IT IS THE PROCESS THAT IS IMPORTANT AND NOT THE PRODUCT, WE ARE NOT LOOKING FOR PERFECT BUT **ENJOYING THE EXPERIENCE** OF CREATION, BASICALLY, SOME PEOPLE LIKE COLOURING IN THE LINES. OTHERS DON'T - NEITHER ARE WRONG AND EVERYONE IS RIGHT AT COMPOST KIDS.

A NOTE ABOUT

MATERIALS: COMPOST KIDS WAS ALWAYS ABOUT MAKING THINGS WITH WHAT YOU HAVE TO HAND! SO KEEP THOSE LOO ROLLS. A COUPLE OF AMAZON BOXES. AN EGG BOX AND ANY PLASTIC TUBS - NOT SO YOUR HOUSE LOOKS LIKE A **RECYCLING DEPOT JUST SO** YOU HAVE A FEW THINGS TO PLAY WITH, SOME BASICS. SELLOTAPE. GLUE STICK. PVA GLUE, SOME PAINTS, PENCILS, FELT TIP PENS, WHITE PAPER, WHITE CARD ARE GREAT. **OUR PLANS ARE JUST GUIDES** AND IDEAS THOUGH SO IF YOU **DON'T HAVE A PARTICULAR MATERIAL THERE IS SOMETHING VERY ENJOYABLE ABOUT PROBLEM SOLVING AND** COMING UP WITH YOUR OWN VERSION.



A NOTE FOR LITTLE
PEOPLE: IF YOU ARE
WORKING WITH LITTLE ONES
THEY CAN NEED MORE HELP,
SO WE HAVE GIVEN YOU HINTS
AT THINGS THEY CAN DO ON

VALERIA PALMEIRO IS BEST KNOWN AS ARTIST COCO DAVEZ, SHE LIVES IN MADRID WHERE SHE WORKS AS A SELF— TAUGHT PAINTER AND ART DIRECTOR.

SHE STARTED HER CAREER AS AN ILLUSTRATOR AND NOW SELLS HER WORK ALL OVER THE WORLD, HER CREATIVE COLLABORATIONS HAVE BEEN WITH BRANDS SUCH AS VOGUE, CHANEL, DIOR, MINI, PUMA AND MANY MORE. AMONGST THESE PROJECTS SHE WAS COMMISSIONED BY NETFLIX TO CREATE ARTWORK FOR THE HIT SERIES STRANGER THINGS.

SHE IS MOST FAMOUS FOR HER SERIES OF PAINTING FACELESS. LIKE MR BRAINWASH AND ANDY WARHOL, DAVEZ LOOKS AT **SOCIETY'S OBSESSION WITH** ICONS. HER SUBJECTS RANGE FROM FAMOUS FILM STARS. MUSICIANS, ARTISTS AND **CARTOON CHARACTERS. EACH PORTRAIT IS MINIMALISED** TO THEIR BASIC FORMS. **ABSTRACTING THE PAINTING** TO JUST SHOW THE SUBJECTS **MOST FAMOUS FEATURES.** SHE PAINTS THESE IN HER SIGNATURE PALETTE OF BRIGHT COLOURS.

SELF PORTRAITS

WHAT YOU NEED

- **PENCIL**
- **WHITE PAPER**
- BLACK PEN (FELT TIP, SHARPIE, OR FINE LINER)
- **4** A RANGE OF COLOURFUL
- PAPER OR CARD (MAKE SURE ONE OF THE COLOURS IS BLACK)
- **GLUE**
- **SCISSORS**



STEPS

1. DRAW A PICTURE
OF YOURSELF USING
A PENCIL (HAVE A
LOOK AT YOURSELF IN
THE MIRROR OR USE A
PHOTOGRAPH OR PRINT
OUT A PICTURE OF
YOURSELF.

2. USING A BLACK PEN DRAW BLACK LINES TO DEFINE THE DIFFERENT SHAPES OF YOUR FACE, HAIR, NECK AND ACCESSORIES.

3. CUT OUT ALL THE PIECES AND PLACE EACH SHAPE ON THE

COLOUR PAPER, TRACE AROUND THE SHAPES AND CUT OUT AGAIN.

4. STICK DOWN IN ORDER.

5. DON'T FORGET THAT COCO DAYEZ USES BLACK AS SHADOW UNDER THE CHIN SO YOU MIGHT WANT TO ADD THIS AFTER. PAPER.

NOTE: OBVIOUSLY THIS TECHNIQUE CAN BE USED TO CREATE ANYONES FACE NOT JUST YOUR OWN.

FOR THE LITTLE ONES: KEEP IT SIMPLE, GET THEM TO DRAW STRAIGHT ONTO THE COLOUR PAPER, THEN CUT OUT HAIR AND ACCESSORIES AND STICK ON.



FACELESS PAINTINGS

WHAT YOU NEED

- PRINTER OR MAGAZINE
- **PENCIL**
- WHITE PAPER OR CARD
- **ITRACING PAPER OR**
- **GREASEPROOF PAPER**
- **BLACK PEN (FELT TIP.**
- **SHARPIE, OR FINE LINER**
- **© PAINTS**



- 1. FIND A FAMOUS FACE IN A MAGAZINE OR ONLINE
- 2. PRINT THIS OUT OR TEAR OUT THE PAGE, YOU WANT THE FACE TO FILL AN A4 PIECE OF PAPER.
- 3. TRACE THE OUTLINES OF THE FACE, HAIR AND ACCESSORIES USING THE TRACING PAPER AND TRANSFER ONTO A CANVAS, BOARD OR THICK PAPER. OR HOLD THE PICTURE UP TO A WINDOW AND TRACE THE OUTLINE OF THE PICTURE ON THE REVERSE OF THE PAPER.
- 4. USE THE BLACK PEN TO DEFINE THE LINES AND THEN PAINT EACH SPACE WITH BRIGHT SINGLE COLOURS.



FOR THE LITTLE ONES:
DON'T BOTHER WITH THE
TRACING BIT JUST PRINT OUT
SOME FAMOUS (CARTOON
CHARACTERS ARE GREAT FOR
THIS) AND GET THEM TO PAINT
EACH AREA OF THE FACE WITH A
DIFFERENT COLOUR.

OR

PUT THE FACE IN A PLASTIC FILE. GET OUT THE PLAY DOH OR PLASTICINE, USE A ROLLING PIN AND GET THEM TO PLACE THE DIFFERENT COLOURS IN EACH AREA OF THE FACE.




COASTERS

WHAT YOU NEED

- **CARDBOARD BOX**
- **WHITE CARD**
- GLUE
- SCISSORS
- **ACRYLIC PAINT**
- **WAX CRAYONS**
- **PAINT PENS (OPTIONAL)**

COCO DAVEZ DESIGNED A SERIES OF PACKAGING FOR DRINKS BRAND BOMBAY SAPPHIRE, WE THOUGHT IT WOULD BE FUN TO PRODUCE OUR OWN VERSION. HAVE A LOOK FOR THEM ON HER WEBSITE.




STEPS

- 1. PRINT OUT THE HEXAGONS WE HAVE PROVIDED THIS IS ONE OF THESE MAKES THAT IS BETTER PRINTED ON CARD OR THICK PAPER.
- 2. USING THE WAX CRAYONS DRAW SHAPES AND MARKS, A LEMON PERHAPS OR CORIANDER LEAVES OR BUBBLES OR STARS. YOU CAN DRAW ACROSS THE SHAPES EACH ONE DOES NOT HAVE TO BE EXCLUSIVE TO THE OTHER, THE DESIGN GOING OFF WILL LOOK COOL.
- 3. USE THE PAINTS TO DO A WASH OVER THE TOP.
- 4. USE PAINT PENS TO ADD EXTRA VIBRANT MARKS.
- 5. GLUE THE SHEET ONTO THICK CARDBOARD FROM A BOX AND CUT OUT THE HEXAGONS.

BONUS MAKE

COCO USES A VERY COOL EYE IN A LOT OF HER DESIGNS, FIND THE ROUND LID OF AN ICE-CREAM TUB AND PAINT IT IN A BOLD ACRYLIC PAINT COLOUR. DRAW OR CUT OUT OUR EYE AND STICK IT ON. YOU CAN EITHER HANG THIS ON YOUR WALL AS A LITTLE GRAPHIC ART OR CUT DOWN THE SIDES, PUT A MAGNET ON THE BACK AND PUT IT ON THE FRIDGE.





PAINTED TERRACOTTA POTS

WHAT YOU NEED


- **ITERRACOTTA POTS**
- **4 ACRYLIC PAINTS**
- **PVA GLUE**

COCO DAVEZ PRODUCED A SERIES OF CERAMIC VESSELS WHICH HAVE INSPIRED US FOR OUR SIMPLE LAST MAKE. YOU CAN FIND THEM ON HER ONLINE SHOP.

SIMPLY PAINT THE POTS WITH A WHITEWASH, THEN USING STRONG BRIGHT COLOURS PAINT WITH MARKS

IF YOU WANT THE PAINTS TO LAST IT IS A GOOD IDEA TO MIX SOME PVA GLUE INTO THE PAINT.

COCO DAVEZ USES SIMPLE STARS AND SPOTS AND LINES, AND IT IS THE VIBRANT COLOURS, AND THE SPACES IN BETWEEN THAT MAKE THEM SO EFFECTIVE. YOU CAN SEE THIS IN THE EXAMPLE OF THE WALLPAPER SHE DESIGNED.



FOR THE BIG PEOPLE: COCO DAVEZ'S
ARTWORK IS DEFINED BY THE BOLD
COLOUR PALETTES SHE USES. SO WHY NOT
INVESTIGATE COLOUR.
SPEND SOME TIME ON APPS LIKE PANTONE
STUDIO OR PALETTES OR JUST RESEARCH
COLOUR USING PINTEREST WHICH HAS MANY
WAYS TO SEARCH AND SHOW COLOUR.
MAKE UP YOUR OWN COLOUR PALETTES, USE
PAINT OR PENCIL TO REALLY LEARN WHAT
COLOURS WORK TOGETHER AND USE THEM
TO DEFINE YOUR OWN ARTWORK.
